**RULES**

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

No national prescriptions will apply.

Racing rule G1.1(b) is deleted. National letters will not be required.

If there is a conflict between languages, the English text will take precedence.

**ADVERTISING**

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

**ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

Registration will open on **March 15<sup>th</sup> 2019** with the intent to accommodate 24/72\* competitors on the Youth event and 48/72\* competitors on the Masters.

Youth entries above 24 will be put on a waiting list. Masters entries above 48 will be put on a waiting list also.

On **July 1<sup>st</sup> 2019** any open spaces from one category will be distributed to people on the other waiting list. For example 30 Youth and 42 Masters.

If the total participants and waiting list exceeds 80 participants, it will be opened to 72 Master and 72 Youth. In this case, they will race at different times of the day and some hand over of boats will be required. See the Race schedule (5.2)

Youth entrants must not reach their 19th birthday during the 2019 calendar year.

Master entrants shall be 40 years of age or older as of September 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2019.

Each competitor shall be a 2019 member of his/her respective country's Class Association.

Registration fee includes as a minimum: finger food at the opening ceremony, awards ceremony barbeque. Additional activities will be announced at registration at the venue.

Registration fee is in US Dollars and shall be free of any transfer and/or banking costs and/or commissions. Any charge shall be reimbursed by competitors to complete their registrations.

Registration fee is non-refundable, unless all spots are filled by the date of the regatta. Refunds of entry fees are subject to a 10% administrative fee.

Eligible competitors may apply by completing the registration form available on-line at <http://sunfishclass.org/worlds>. NSCAs and National Sailing Authorities can secure berths for their countries by completing a registration form, sending a payment, and nominating their competitors at a later date. Once a competitor has been nominated, replacement with alternates will not be allowed.

Registrations are not considered official until all the payments have been received by the ISCA Office. Competitors can pay the registration fee by credit card, check, or wire transfer.

Boats that were used by Worlds sailors who choose not to compete in this Championship will be assigned to the last competitors to register.

Boats that have not been used by Worlds sailors will be assigned to the first competitors to register.

In case we have more than 80 participants (both Youth and Masters) there will be a handover during race days.

Competitors that register late will be the first to committed to handovers.
